Gold open access - articles freely available immediately upon publication on publisher's website - no embargo period. APC applicable*

Green open access - articles are made available by archiving in an institutional or subject repository - embargo period may apply, depending on the publisher's self-archiving policy.

*Article Processing Charge (APC) - a fee that is charged to authors in order to publish an article in an open access academic journal. This fee covers the costs associated with the publishing process.


Compliance with funder mandates

Open access timeline at Palgrave Macmillan

June 2011 Palgrave Macmillan took the lead in offering open access across 18 of its academic journals. Today, the portfolio has now expanded to includes over 40 journals with the open access option.

November 2013
The first open access monograph was published.



July 2014 The first 'hybrid' open access chapter was published.

October 2014 The first open access Palgrave Pivot was published.

The open access option was expanded to include monographs and Palgrave Pivots. This was made possible through a books processing charge, which is usually paid for by research funders. The default license for our open access books is CC-BY, but other licenses are available on request.

January 2015 *Palgrave Communications*, the first fully open access multidisciplinary journal was launched.



*Preferred by many research funding bodies, the CCBY licence allows readers to alter, transform, or build upon the article and then distribute the resulting work as long as the original work is correctly cited. Palgrave Macmillan was the first humanities and social science publisher to offer this licence across all publication formats.
